



## Roar and Snore fact sheet

### Kit List – items you need to bring with you:

- Sleeping bag, pillow and mattress
- Camera
- Toiletries – toilets within walking distance and open all night (please note there are no showers – this is a camping experience, we do have an outback bush shower available for those who want to get in touch with nature bring your towel)
- Roar and Snore is an all-weather program. Bring wet-weather gear and warm clothing/bedding if you think you will need it
- Torch (to be used at the Campsite Area not for the Twilight Walk)
- Pump for air mattress if needed
- Sensible walking shoes

### We provide meals including:

- Light Refreshments
- Dinner
- Supper (tea, coffee, hot chocolate etc)
- Buffet breakfast

### Where & when to meet:

At Taronga Western Plains Zoo main gate at 5.45pm. Please call (02) 6881 1405 if you should be late. Please note that due to time restraints with the program if you arrive after 7pm – guests will not be able to re-join the program until after the Twilight Walk has been completed – approx 9.30pm.

6.30pm – Classroom Animal Encounter  
7.30pm – Dinner  
8.00pm – Twilight Walk  
9.30pm – Supper - Campfire (weather permitting)  
10.30pm – Bedtime!  
6.00am – Rise and Shine!  
6.30am – Early Morning Walk behind-the-scenes  
8.45am – Buffet Breakfast  
9.30am – Finish (you can spend the day in the Zoo until it closes at 5pm)

**How large are the tents?**

The tents measure 3m x 3m – and fit four (4) normal sized adults.

**Do we have to share our tent with other guests?**

No. Only families or people who have booked in together will share the same tent.

**What is inside the tents?**

The tents are completely empty, with a solid canvas floor. You will need to bring all your own sleeping equipment for a comfortable sleeping experience (air mattress / sleeping bag / swag / pillow).

**Where and when do I meet my tour guide?**

You will need to arrive at the Front Gates of the Zoo at 5.45pm – please park to the LHS. Your hosts for the evening will meet you there and let you in.

**Am I able to enter the zoo any earlier than this**

No. The following day after completing your Roar and Snore experience is when you have access to the wonders of the Zoo and it's surroundings.

**Can children under 5 years old attend the Roar and Snore program?**

No. Due to occupational health and safety regulations and the nature of the program – children under the age of FIVE are NOT allowed to attend.  
If this is not adhered to – you maybe asked to leave and void any payments made.

**Can you cater for my special dietary requirements**

Yes. Vegetarian, Lactose Intolerant and Gluten Free meals can be catered for. Please include information on your booking form. For other speciality diets please enquire at your time of booking.

**Can alcohol be bought into the zoo?**

No A minimum amount of complimentary drinks are provided to enjoy with your meal. Strictly no additional alcohol may be brought onto the Zoo premises.

**How long do the tours in the program run for?**

The Twilight Tour runs for approximately one and a half hours (1 ½ hours). The Early Morning Walk runs for approximately two hours (2 hours).

**What animals will I see?**

You will see a variety of both native and exotic animals. Your experience will include up close and personal – as well as behind the scenes encounters.
